Over the coming weeks, the CAO will hold discussions with the State Examinations Commission about the expected revised timeline for the provision of Leaving Certificate examinations and results.

Online late applications are still being accepted up to 17:15 on **1st May 2020**. To make a late application click on 'Apply'.

The CAO Change of Mind facility will operate as usual, opening at noon on the **5th May 2020** and closing at 17:15 on **1st July 2020**.

Info For Fifth Year Students

For those of you who are interested in making an application to a university in the UK for 2021 the first deadline to note is **October 15th** 2020, please email your interest to the guidance counsellors.

This first deadline is for applications to Medicine, Veterinary, Dentistry and Oxbridge only.

*As the application form has several parts and courses frequently require pre-interview tests students usually start this process during the summer holidays.

UCAS, like CAO, are trying to manage the impact of COVID 19. Those of you who have offers or are expecting offers will be informed by UCAS.

UCAS would like you to know they will be flexible regarding start dates for the next academic year. They have already extended the deadline by which colleges can make offers. See the dates below:

20 May 2020 – if you sent your application by 15 January 2020.

13 July 2020 – if you sent your application by 30 June 2020.

20 October 2020 – this is the final deadline for universities to make decisions on applications to courses starting in 2020.

The message is positive; the universities would like to have the current crop of students starting their first year this autumn. They will be flexible.

As soon as we have a results date for Leaving Cert results you can all breathe a bit easier.
