Late applications for CAO will be accepted up until **17.15 on May 1st**. The CAO Change of Mind facility will open at noon on **May 5th**.

Students who have not already included any CAO courses on their application may now add in their course choices. Most importantly, all CAO applicants may now alter their list of courses. You may add or delete courses, and you may alter the order of your course choices.

You may make changes to your choices as often as you like until this facility closes.

The CAO website includes college alert lists that can be found in the "Student Resources". For example there is a new course in NCI which may be of interest to some students, it is a level 8 course NC030 - BA honours in Early Childhood Education and Care.
