ORAL & PRACTICAL Examinations Guidelines Easter 2021

- **Provisional details of the date, time and location** of your oral / practical exam will be available on the noticeboards outside the 1st floor office from 1.00pm on Thursday, the 25th of March.
- We are requesting students to be present in school for, **at most one hour only prior** to the oral / practical exam.
- On your arrival to school, on the day of the oral / practical, you will need to go straight to the 1st floor office - where you will be **requested to sign in on the SEC Roll** for your oral / practical with Margaret or Lauren.
- **NB.** You will need to bring a form of **Photo Identification** with you to the oral / practical. Your IOE student card, passport or driver's license will be acceptable.
- The Raymond Kearns Hall will be available to students when they come in to school to await their oral / practical only. There will be no study facilities available to students over the Easter period. Study finishes for the duration of the Easter holidays on Friday, the 26th of March at 5pm.
- **Two students at a time only** will be permitted to sit outside the room (socially distanced) where the oral / practical exam will take place, for 15 minutes before the oral / practical.
- **PLEASE NOTE** that all oral interviewers and candidates are required to **WEAR MASKS** for the duration of the interview, with the exception of those exempted from wearing masks normally.
