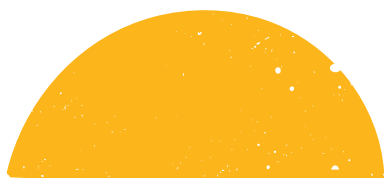
### VETERINARY MEDICINE IN POLAND
