5TH YEAR

As you're finishing up with your classes this week, we'd like to wish you the very best of luck in your end of year exams and wish you a wonderful summer holiday.

6TH YEAR

Have you checked your CAO statement of application record? It has happened in the past that our students didn't receive round 1 offers because their details weren't correct. There is a very helpful video on the CAO website which you can watch here <https://www.cao.ie/index.php?page=video&l=417724441>



The most common errors are:

1. Check that the CAO have the CORRECT Leaving Certificate number. It has happened that students' previous school registered them for the Leaving Certificate, so effectively they were registered twice – it is vitally important that your CAO application contains the Leaving Cert number that you have registered and that you will be writing on your exam papers.
2. If you have an NUI Irish/3rd language exemption check that it is noted on your CAO statement of application record. If it isn't, contact exemptions@nui.ie without delay.
3. Repeat students make sure the details of your previous sitting of the Leaving Cert. are recorded.
