

#### **6TH YEARS**

If you haven't seen a guidance counsellor yet to go over your plans for next year please do so – we're looking forward to meeting you and supporting you with your decision making.

#### UCAS

Remember that offers are made on a rolling basis, so it's optimal to get your application submitted early. If you'd like your application to be submitted to UCAS before Christmas, pay and submit before Monday 9<sup>th</sup> December. All other applications must be paid and submitted by Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January. Don't forget that you are submitting to the centre (school). We then review your application, add predicted grades and reference, all of which take time before we send it to UCAS on your behalf. If you'd like feedback on your personal statement, you must see a guidance counsellor before Christmas.

#### HPAT

HPAT 2024 registration is now open with ACER HPAT Ireland. You will need a CAO number to register. The test window is 14<sup>th</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup> of February and it costs €160.80. Sittings on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> February will be for test centre sittings only. Don't forget to schedule your remote proctored sitting with ProctorU after you register. Closing date for registration is 17<sup>th</sup> of January 2025 but we recommend getting in early.
