

Some of the very best young debaters from around the country came together in pursuit of an invitation to Oxford. It was an evening of vigorous debate and students battled over issues surrounding A.I. and then the nature of medical autonomy. The Institute had four fantastic teams in the competition, as well as two swing teams of students eager to sample the rigours of this level of debate. The Institute's own Lina Hassan and Nare Paronyan (pictured above) were one of the three teams chosen to represent Ireland in Oxford at the finals on March 15th. ## STUDENT SPOTLIGHT



Well done to 6<sup>th</sup> year Aditya Joshi, who has been recognised as the runner-up at the prestigious TECS Education Awards. The event, held at the University of Limerick, celebrates innovation and excellence in education and highlights some of the most inspiring projects from students across the country. Aditya designed a Spotify music controller inspired by a retro record player, combining modern music streaming with a vinyl-like experience. The device features an ESP32 microcontroller, rotary encoder for input, and a 3D-printed case, enabling users to control tracks and volume through physical interactions. His project uses Spotify's API to display album art and sync a spinning disc with playback, showcasing technology with nostalgia.

#### **CAO – APPLICATION DEADLINE**

The closing date for CAO applications is Saturday the 1st of February 2025 at 5pm. Certain courses are Restricted-Application courses which require additional assessment procedures e.g. HPAT, the submission of a portfolio/oral assessment/audition/interview or a written assessment. Please be aware that an application for a Restricted-Application course will not be considered unless it has been included among your original course choices by 1st February. The guidance team are here to support you so drop in between 8:30-9:30am any morning or make an appointment using the QR code.

DARE applicants please note that when you are completing Section A online you must click the "Submit button" at the bottom of the page. It is not enough to simply click "Save". 
