Congratulations to 6th year Joel Emmanuel who represented Ireland at the FIRST (For Inspiration & Recognition of Science & Technology) Robotics Global Challenge 2025, held in Panama City from the 29th of October to the 1st of November. The Irish National Team ranked 8th out of 191 countries this year - the highest placement an Irish team has ever achieved in this global "Olympics-style" robotics competition. The theme always ties into real-world issues. This year's theme, "Eco Equilibrium" encouraged students to design robots and projects that help restore habitats, protect species, and model sustainable systems.

Well done to 6th year student Harris Mirza who has once again made us proud, winning the Bronze certificate in the 2025 International Astronomy and Astrophysics Competition (IAAC). This placed Harris among the top 15% of over 12,000 participants worldwide. The IAAC is an educational science competition that enables students from all countries to test their skills in astronomy and astrophysics.


